

# **FPM SPECIAL FIELD REGULATIONS**

All flight activities must comply with the  
AMA National Model Aircraft Safety Code and FPM Special Field Regulations

## **PROHIBITED FLYING AREAS**

- West of the pilot stations – the safety line
- The National Wildlife Refuge
- Over buildings, parking lots, public roads or near persons working within approved flying areas
- Near the dike at the south end of the flying area

## **OPERATING REGULATIONS**

- A valid AMA card must be on the frequency control board prior to turning on a transmitter
- Registration with the FAA Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems (sUAS) program required
- Flying near birds prohibited
- Aerobatics, helicopter operations and low passes must be east of the runway
- Taxiing prohibited in the pit area
- Take offs to the south must turn left as soon as safely possible
- Declare your flight path intentions to the other pilots
- First Person View (FPV) operations must have a spotter, fly within the approved FPM flying boundaries and comply with AMA Document 550

## **GENERAL REGULATIONS**

- Fixed wing turbine aircraft not permitted
- Use of the field limited to FPM members and their AMA/MAAC member guests
- Spectators must remain west of the tables
- Alcoholic beverages and Marihuana/Cannabis/Cannabinoids are prohibited
- Discharging of fireworks, firearms or launching of rockets prohibited
- Trash must not be left at the field
- Pets must be leashed

## **GUEST PILOT POLICY**

FPM policy is to share use of the club field with guest pilots who are proficient, AMA/MACC members, registered with the FAA and a member of an AMA/MACC chartered club. A guest pilot must be the guest of an FPM member. The FPM member host must brief a guest pilot on the FPM Special Field Regulations and be present while the guest is using the field. A guest pilot may not fly alone at the field. Guests flying at the FPM field on a frequent basis are required to join the FPM.
